

TARGETS TO SUCCESS

Attendance-

You should be aiming to have 100% attendance at the end of Year 10 and Year 11

- 90% Attendance is equivalent to missing 4 full weeks of school
- 90% of students with less than 85% attendance fail to achieve 5 or more good GCSE Grades.

The GO 4 Schools Parent App is free for parents to download from the Apple and Android App stores, but you will not be able to log in unless your child's school has a current SO 4 School subscreption that includes the App, and they have granted you access. Your child's school will let you know if and when they have added the App to the school's subscription.

The App uses the same login details (email address and password) as this web site.
