Future Needs

- Colleges and Sixth Forms (and universities) are increasingly looking for a broad and balanced curriculum to have been studied with a focus on EBacc subjects (the English Baccalaureate).
 - English
 - Mathematics
 - Sciences

- Humanities (Geography or History)
- Languages (French or Spanish)







Maths, English, Science, MFL and Geography or History

- The English Baccalaureate includes academic subjects highly valued by some colleges and universities
- Russell Group universities value language skills but there is no universal entry requirement for students to have studied a modern foreign language at GCSE or equivalent. Check whether there are any course-specific requirements.





Why choose to study a language?

- Languages are recognised as difficult subjects by employers and colleges.
- Therefore, this makes you stand out among your peers, especially when numbers are decreasing.
- Great opportunities, especially when travelling reading signs, talking to people in their own language, especially when some people will only speak to you if you make and effort in their language.
- Appreciation of other cultures.
- Studies show that learning a language improves logic, reasoning and memory.

Please note that we cannot guarantee any subject choice for any student. Some subjects may not run if there is insufficient interest from pupils.




