





- We will also take into account the number of positive points students have achieved on Go4schools.



- Monday Friday


#### **After this date: (Thursday 6th June)**

- Check your name and date of birth is correct

- If you are ill on the morning of your exam:
- Contact the school immediately
  - Speak to Mrs Bromley or Miss Field
- Try to come in for the exam
  - Separate room
  - Scribe
- If you are genuinely unable, we require medical evidence from a medical professional
  - Doctors letter
  - JCQ Self Certification form
