# School Uniform...



- Skirt – Must have school logo & must be worn at knee length.
- Trousers - straight leg, full length, not skinny leg style, jeans style or leggings.
- Shirts – traditional shirt, must be tucked into waistband and worn with a tie.
- Shoes – flat leather black, toes enclosed. No trainers or trainer styles.

# Jewellery & Make Up...

- A plain simple ring
- A pair of ear studs (one small stud per ear)

  - Nose/eyebrow/tongue studs or any other type piercings are not permitted

# Planner...



- Keep neat and tidy

  - A summary of the homework task
  - Date due in
- Parents/Carers are asked to check and talk to child about homework etc. Form Tutor will also check and discuss.
- Can be used as a point of contact between home/school for basic information.

# Mobile Phones...

**Should be handed in to reception or
