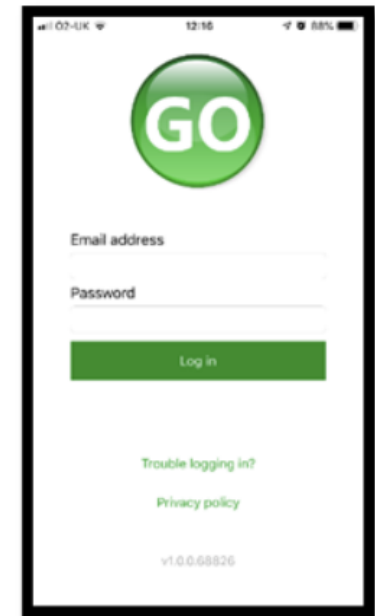

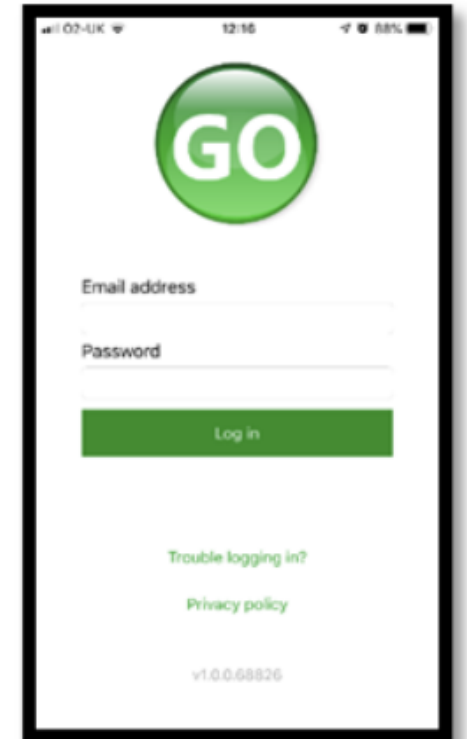


# Go4Schools...

'Forgot Password'

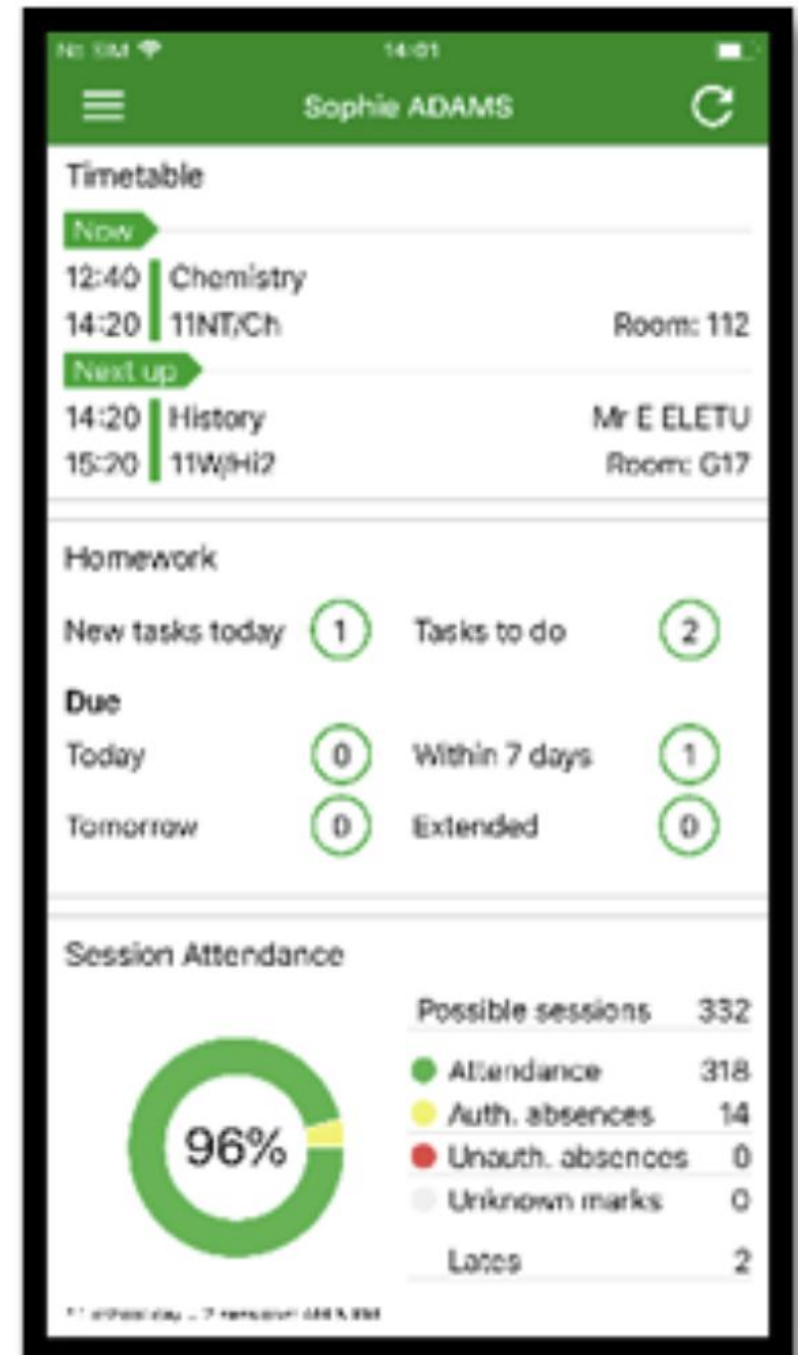

- Progress

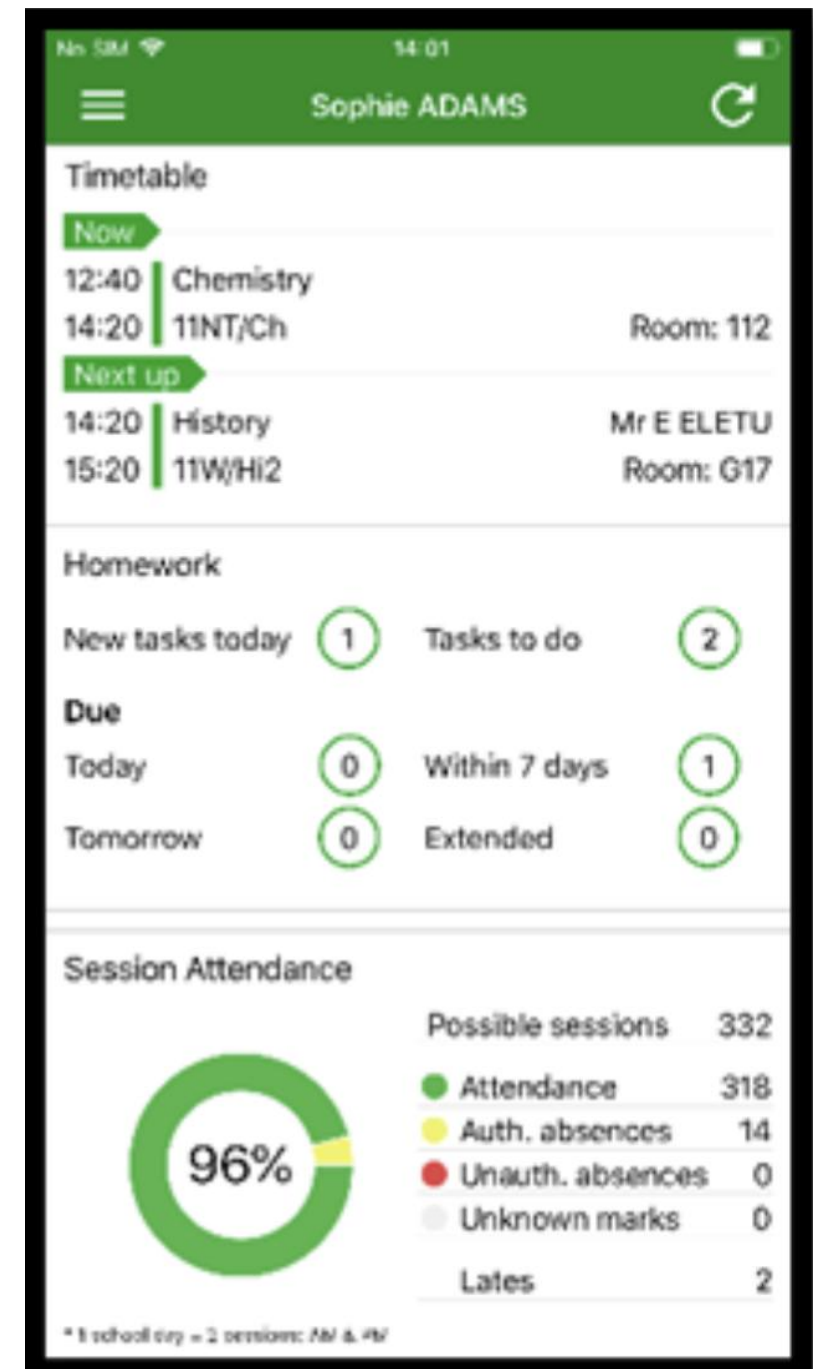


# Go4Schools...

**Students should be achieving 95% or higher attendance.**




# Go4Schools...

Staff will input specific detail about the event so you can support at home.



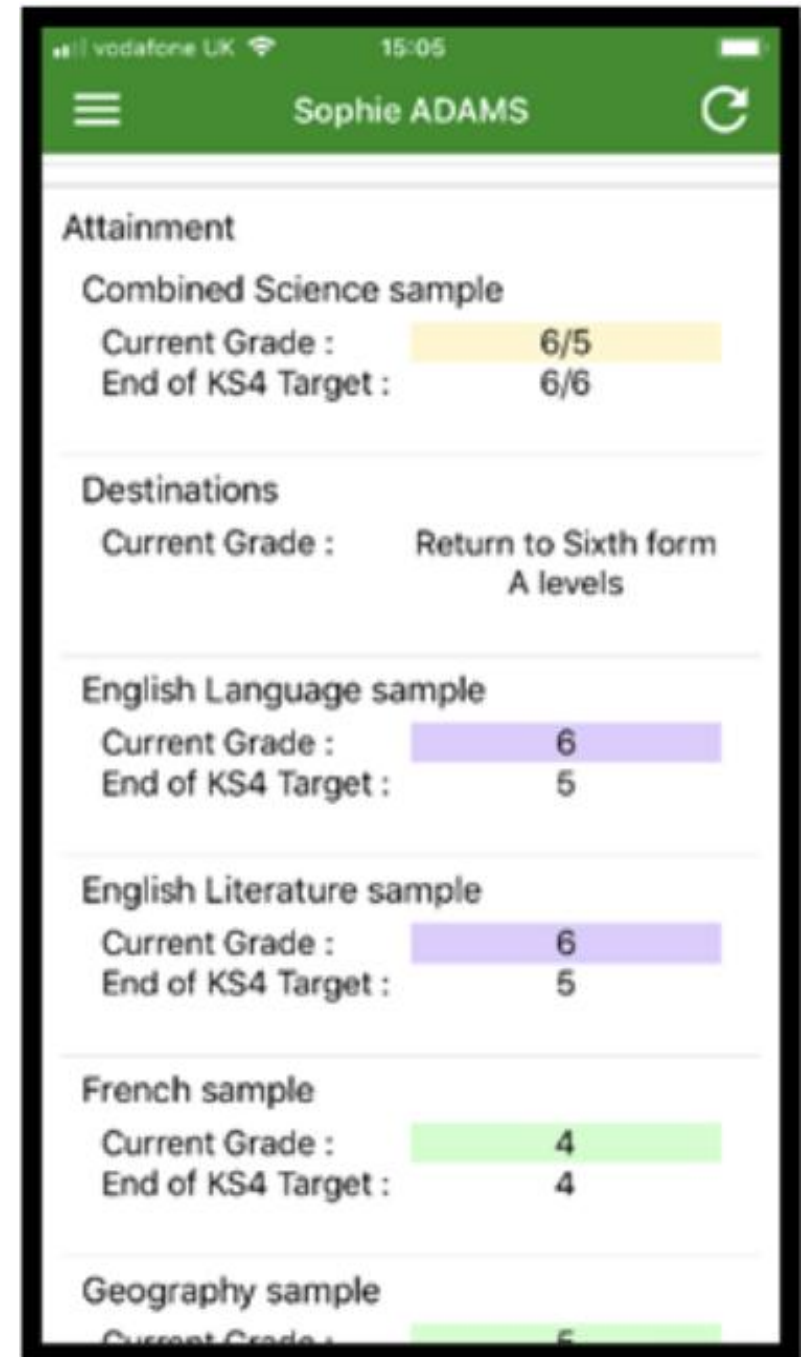

# Mobile Phones...

Mobles Phones are allowed on school site but:

- Must be switched off & in bags, lockers or reception during the school day.

If mobiles phones are seen out during the school day they will be confiscated this includes in outside spaces of the school EG). Quad, Hard Court, Car park

Mobile phones must **not**:

- Be in blazer, trouser, skirt or hoody pockets
- Be in waist bands of skirts/trousers/shorts

If phones are seen in pockets, they will be confiscated!

If your phone is confiscated:

First time in a half term:

- Taken to reception for parents/carers to collect

Second time in half term:

- Taken to reception for parents/carers to collect
- 1 day in IEU

You may also be instructed to hand your mobile in to reception at the start of the school day until the end of that half term.

# Bus Behaviour...

Norfolk transport are responsible for:

- Bus Passes
  - o They are not replaced each year.
- Replacement Bus Passes
  - o There is a cost
  - o Temporary passes from reception only last for 5 days

They are also responsible for:

- Sending warning letters RE behaviour
- Issuing Bus bans for poor behaviour

You **CANNOT** travel on any other bus other than your own

## Behaviour on the bus:



- Sit towards the front of the bus
- Remain in your seat
- Wear a seat belt
- No throwing
- Litter to be placed in bags or bin
- Appropriate language (No shouting)
- Phone to be used responsibly
- Do not distract the driver

Be kind and thoughtful towards others.
