




Once you have registered on the **website** you can download the app for IOS and Android.

On the home screen will need to enter your email address and password


You can reset passwords by pressing 'Forgot Password'





The home page will then show you:



- Lates to registration


Students should be achieving 95% or higher attendance.

- Click on '**details'** for more information about the event


Staff will input specific detail about the event so you can support at home.




On the main screen scroll down to view Attainment







Mobile Phones...

 You may also be instructed to hand your mobile in to reception at the start of the school day until the end of that half term.

Bus Behaviour...

Norfolk transport are responsible for:

- Bus Passes
 - They are not replaced each year.
- Replacement Bus Passes
 - o There is a cost
 - Temporary passes from reception only last for 5 days

They are also responsible for:

- Sending warning letters RE behaviour
- Issuing Bus bans for poor behaviour

You **CANNOT** travel on any other bus other than your own

Behaviour on the bus:

- Sit towards the front of the bus
- Remain in your seat
- Wear a seat belt
- No throwing
- Litter to be placed in bags or bin
- Appropriate language (No shouting)
- Phone to be used responsibly
- Do not distract the driver
