- Work in active partnership with families, including offering meaningful opportunities for parents and carers to get involved in school life and feedback forums

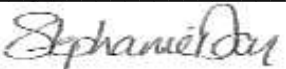
Parents/Carers – we will do our best to:

- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and on time, working collaboratively with the school to overcome any barriers to attendance. I will notify the school if my child will be absent on each day of absence
- Ensure that my child is dressed in the correct school uniform and brings the necessary equipment to school
- Communicate with the school any concerns or problems that might affect my child's well-being, behaviour in school or ability to engage with learning
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for ensuring my child maintains a consistently high level of behaviour, including the schools' approach to mobile phones
- Regularly check/monitor my child's use of social media, contact the police where required and seek advice from school where necessary
- Support my child in completing homework on time and raise any concerns with their subject teachers
- Engage in parents'/carers' evenings and discussions about my child's progress and/or behaviour to achieve the best outcomes for my child

- Ensure that communication with the school is effective and respectful and that all members of the school community are treated with care and respect
- Understand that staff may not be available for unarranged meetings during the school day and that meetings will need to be arranged at a date/time suitable for all parties

Students - I will do my best to:

- Attend school regularly and arrive to school and lessons on time, ready to learn
- Wear the correct school uniform with pride and bring the correct equipment, books and PE Kit every day
- Try my best to complete classwork and homework to the best of my ability and ask for help if needed
- Show respect for learning by treating all members of the school community with care and respect both in person and online
- Take part in the school's enrichment activities and clubs
- Speak to an adult about any worries or concerns that I might have that might affect my wellbeing, work/behaviour or the safety of other pupils
- Show respect for the school environment and local community at all times
- Understand and follow the school rules, including for mobile phones and electronic devices, and complete sanctions in line with the behaviour policy where rules have not been followed
- Behave appropriately and safely on the journey to and from school and on any school trips, including those outside of school time
